All year our members can enjoy our two spacious 0-50 yard pistol/rifle ranges, our 100 yard rifle range, two trap fields and one archery only range. We are a private club with a membership capacity of 275.

**Join us each month for our regular member meetings held the 4th Thursday** of each month at 7 pm. When the weather permits, we meet at the range clubhouse and during winter months we may be at the Monticello VFW for the member meeting. Check the website or Facebook to confirm the meeting location.

### Membership is granted on an annual basis and runs from April 1st to March 31st.

- Sign up for Renewing Members will be done through a mail in process with packets being mailed out in January with a return date of February 15<sup>th</sup>.
- **NOTE:** If you were a member for the previous year and you fail to renew membership by the March deadline, your spot will **not be held**.
- New Member sign ups begin in April and will be by invitation in the order of the names on our waitlist.
   To add your name to the waitlist, please go to the Membership page and follow the link to the waitlist sign up form.
- After membership renewals in March, any available spots will be offered to people on the waitlist until our cap of 275 is met – NO WALK INS.

#### Requirements to become a member include:

- ALL members must pay annual dues/processing fee and complete required membership paperwork.
- New members must complete Range Walk-Thru in person (must be signed off by a MR&GC RSO)

To sign up, **ALL** Members must present the following:

- A valid Minnesota Permit to Purchase OR Permit to Carry honored in the state of Minnesota (Active Military or Law Enforcement may present a valid Military ID / LEO I.D.)
- A valid Minnesota ID or US Passport
- A completed Member Application Form
- Signed Hold Harmless Agreement

## Although we are a private Club, we "welcome the public" to join us for these activities\*-

#### **WEEKLY LEAGUE SHOOTING:**

- Wednesday evenings summer and fall trap leagues and public practice trap shooting.
- Thursday evening pistol / carbine night. (April-Sept.) every Thurs. night except the 4th Thurs. which is our membership meeting night at the club.
- Firearms training avail. by various trainers.

#### PUBLIC RIFLE SITE-IN:

 Each fall our range is available for public rifle sight in to prepare for deer hunting season. Held every weekend (Sat.-Sun.) the month of October from 10am to 4 pm.

# Basic Firearms Safety Rules

- ALWAYS keep the gun pointed in a safe direction.
- ALWAYS keep your finger off the trigger until ready to shoot.
- ALWAYS keep the gun unloaded until ready to shoot.



Please take note, read and follow all directions on signs posted throughout the range. **Thank you!** 

## Remember These Range Safety Rules:

- **1.** Make sure that no one is in front of, or within 90 degrees either side of the shooting direction before any guns are handled
- 2. The loading and chambering of rounds / shells is to be done only after the gun is aimed at the berm and not before (hinged actions can be aimed forward at the ground).
- 3. Upon completion of firing, open the action and verify the gun is unloaded while it is still aimed at the berm (hinged actions can be aimed forward at the ground
- **4.** No firing at anything lying on the ground or at the top of berms, No Steel Targets Only paper targets allowed at the club.
- **5.** All projectiles are to be fired from stations perpendicular to berms at their respective target locations only. Do not shoot across at an angle into berms, and no shooting at side berms
- **6.** Before anyone moves forward of the firing line at each station, all guns are verified unloaded and laid on benches / tables, or put in cases/range bags with the actions open and not touched. Handguns can also be secured in holsters.
- 7. Coordinate with other shooters on the firing line and at shooting.
- **8.** No one handles a firearm when anyone is forward of the firing line at each station.
- **9.** When leaving, verify all guns are unloaded, clean up the area, removing everything that you brought in, including your targets and empty cases/hulls.
- **10.** Guests are to be supervised at all times and members are responsible for making sure that their guests obey these rules as well as all other club rules. Two guests allowed per member.

For any violations of any of the Range Rules, you will be expected to show up at at monthly members meeting before you are able to use the range again.

## The Club has an elected board of directors and appointed officers.

<u>Elected positions</u>: President, Vice-president, Secretary, Treasurer, Sergeant at Arms, and two Members at Large.

Appointed Officers: NRA Certified. Chief Range Safety Officer, Trap League, Pistol/Carbine League, and Membership Coordinator. See the club website for current board/officer names and contact info.

Please be aware that we are located in a residential neighborhood. We ask you to limit continued rapid fire especially with muzzle breaks creating prolonged loud noise.

# MONTICELLO ROD and GUN CLUB

**HISTORY**: The original Articles of Incorporation for the Club as a non-profit show the start date as September 1, 1946 as "Monticello Gun Club". Terms of Admission to Membership were \$5.00 for life with no annual dues. The original abstract for the Club's current site dates back to June 1, 1861. On July 1, 1958 the property via warranty deed was given to the Club. It was located in the Village of Monticello. In 1977 the corporation name was changed to "Monticello Rod and Gun Club, Inc." The club has been in Monticello for 75 years.

The old photo below shows the club location in 1939 at Tarzan Elms along the Mississippi River. Today, the land in this old photo is owned by the Excel nuclear power plant.



In its early years the club property was located west of and outside of the city. Today, the property boundaries are within the city limits of Monticello at its current address: 1821 River Street West. (Photos shown below.)
