New Membership Application Process

ALL MEMBERS must present a valid Permit to Purchase <u>OR</u> Permit to Carry honored in the State of Minnesota in order to renew or open a membership in the Monticello Rod and Gun Club. Active Military or Law Enforcement may present a valid Military/LEO ID.

- Permit to Purchase applications are free (please see your local Law Enforcement agencies for details).
- Permit to Carry applications and fees are determined by your county sheriff.

Classes that qualify for applications for a Minnesota Permit to Carry a Pistol are offered, for a fee, by several of our members throughout the year. Check our calendar on this website or the Facebook page for current club events.

Please plan on 1 hour – 90 minutes for paperwork and range walk-through The walk-through will take 30 – 45 minutes and will be outside so please dress appropriately.

Membership capacity is 275 – People on the MRGC waitlist will be contacted if openings are available once membership renewals are completed.

- New member applications will be taken starting the first Saturday in April.
- You MUST have a valid Permit to Purchase <u>OR</u> Permit to Carry honored in the State of Minnesota to apply for membership in the Monticello Rod and Gun Club
- You MUST have a valid MN ID or US Passport
- New member applications must be made in person, by appointment, at the MRGC clubhouse.
- New member packets will be made available at the clubhouse and will include the following:
 - Membership Application Form
 - Hold Harmless Agreement
 - New Member Account Summary and Invoice
 - Range Rules & Walk Through
- New Member applicant process:
 - Fill out paperwork at the clubhouse
 - Have picture taken for membership badge
 - Go on a range walk-through with one of the club Range Safety Officers (RSO)
 - Return signed Range Rules & Walk Through at the clubhouse
 - Pick up new badge and gate access code, a copy of the Range Rules, and a copy of the current MRGC By Laws
- Payments must be check, money order, or cashier's check made out to MRGC. We will accept cash for in person applications, however, we are not able to process credit cards.
