

## Membership Renewal Mail-in Process

Membership capacity is 300

**ALL MEMBERS must present a valid Permit to Purchase OR Permit to Carry honored in the State of Minnesota in order to renew or open a membership in the Monticello Rod and Gun Club. Active Military or Law Enforcement may present a valid Military/LEO ID.**

Classes that qualify for applications for a Minnesota Permit to Carry a Pistol are offered, for a fee, by several of our members throughout the year. Check our calendar on this website or the Facebook page for current club events.

- Permit to Purchase applications are free (please see your local Law Enforcement agencies for details).
- Permit to Carry applications and fees are determined by your county sheriff.
- Renewal packets will be mailed out to current members no later than January 10<sup>th</sup>.
- Renewals MUST be postmarked and returned NO LATER THAN March 15<sup>th</sup>.
- In person renewals will be accepted during the January and February member's meetings.
- Payments must be check, money order, or cashier's check made out to MRGC. We are not able to process credit cards.
- Once processed, receipts and new gate code stickers will be mailed out.
- Applications will be taken for renewals from existing members, in good standing, through the mail-in process through March 15<sup>th</sup>. NO NEW MEMBERSHIPS WILL BE PROCESSED AT THIS TIME.
- If current members have not returned their membership packets by the March 15<sup>th</sup> deadline, **THEIR SPOT WILL NOT BE HELD**. This means that any available positions after the renewal deadline will be offered to people on the waitlist until the 300-member cap is reached.
- Existing members will be denied membership if they fail to renew before the March deadline.

**Renewing members must complete and return the following paperwork. Return envelopes will be provided in the renewal packet.**

- Membership Renewal/Application Form
- Account Summary and Invoice
- Hold Harmless Agreement
- Photo copy of a valid Permit to Purchase OR Permit to Carry honored in the State of Minnesota
- Payment made out to MRGC

Incomplete applications will not be processed. Everything you receive in your packet MUST BE RETURNED along with a copy of your permit and your payment.
